Subject Lowering of qualifying percentile of NEET MDS 2017 in respect of candidates belonging to the General Category, SC/ST/OBC and person with locomotory disability of lower limbs - reg

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso contained in clause 2 of Section 3 of the Dental Council of India Revised MDS Course (2nd Amendment) Regulations, 2007, the undersigned is directed to convey that the Central Government, in consultation with the Dental Council of India, has decided to lower the qualifying percentile of NEET MDS 2017 by 7.5 percentile in respect of candidates belonging to the General Category, SC/ST/OBC and persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs for the academic session 2017-18 only. The qualifying percentiles for NEET MDS 2017 for the academic session 2017-18 now stand lowered as under
